DISEC

The United Nations Disarmament and International Security Committee (DISEC), established as the First Committee of the General Assembly in 1945 under the UN Charter, serves a pivotal role in global peace and security affairs. Its primary mandate is to formulate principles on disarmament and arms regulation, providing recommendations to both UN Member States

and the Security Council. While DISEC cannot directly influence Security Council decisions, it suggests agenda items for their consideration. As part of the United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs (UNODA), DISEC collaborates on various disarmament issues, encompassing nuclear weapons, weapons of mass destruction, and conventional arms, thus contributing substantively to international peace efforts through norm-setting and policy guidance.

UNHCR

The United Nations High Commissioner, for Refugees (UNHCR) was established in 1950 following the aftermath of World War II to assist millions of displaced Europeans. To this day it continues to support and protect refugees, asylum seekers, displaced persons and stateless individuals. The UNHCRs main tasks involve safeguarding the rights and well being of refugees promoting solutions such as return, local integration or resettlement in a third country addressing statelessness concerns and upholding international protections, for those displaced. Through its efforts the agency ensures that beneficiaries are given the opportunity to rebuild their lives with dignity.

UNECOSOC

The United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) is one of the six principal organs of the United Nations, established on 26th June 1945. Serving as the central forum for discussing international economic and social issues of the organization, specifically in regards to the fifteen specialized agencies, the eight functional commissions and the five regional commissions under its jurisdiction, and formulating policy recommendations addressed to member states. In addition to a rotating membership of 54 UN member states, over 1,600 nongovernmental organizations have consultative status with the Council to participate in the work of the United Nations.

LOK SABHA

The Lok Sabha is the headquarters of the Indian legislative and executive and is responsible for making political decisions. The Lok Sabha is also known as the House of People and the upper house of Rajya Sabha. The universal suffrage elects members of the Lok Sabha. Members of the Lok Sabha are holding their seats for five years until and unless they are dissolved by the president based on the advice of the council of ministers. The House of the Lok Sabha is the parliament House in New Delhi. The Lok Sabha committee has more power as compared to Rajya Sabha. Lok Sabha enjoys more special powers regarding collective responsibility and financial matters, legislative functions, and Executive functions. The maximum membership of the house is 552 according to the constitution of India but currently, seats are filled by the 543 elected members. Lok Sabha is the main part of the Indian constitution. Each and every thing is controlled by Lok Sabha.
